This Biodynamic[®], single vineyard expression of THE EXTRAORDINARY BLUE HERON RANCH IS A CLASSIC BURGUNDIAN STYLE CHARDONNAY. WITH ITS BRILLIANT. LIGHT GOLDEN STRAW COLOR, THIS WINE SPIKES YOUR CURIOSITY WITH AROMAS OF LEMON CURD AND FIG SPICE THAT ARE COMPLIMENTED ON THE PALATE WITH A CREAMY TEXTURE AND A RICH RIPE MELON FLAVOR. IT THEN FINISHES WITH A TOUCH OF OAK FROM THE LENGTHY BARREL AGING.

TECHNICAL NOTES:

GRAPES WERE HARVESTED AT OPTIMAL RIPENESS OVER AN EXTENDED HARVEST PERIOD. VINEYARD BLOCKS WERE KEPT SEPARATE UNTIL THE BEST LOTS WERE BLENDED TOGETHER. The wine was fermented in 100% French Oak Barrels, 30% NEW, FOR 18 MONTHS.
