NOTES FROM WINEMAKER JEFF CICHOCKI

The wine has aromas of strawberry, key lime, rosewater and hints of pineapple. This vibrant bouquet is consistent on the palate, along with notes of ripe peaches, watermelon and pomegranate. This is a dry Rosé, making it an ideal wine to enjoy on its own, but it is also incredibly versatile to pair with food. Think picnic fare, Asian-fusion, poached salmon, grilled fish or fresh salads.
